FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION: Registration is now open for children who do not currently attend St. Modwen's Catholic School and would like to do their catechism at Church in preparation for Reconciliation, First Holy Communion (children who will be 7 or over by June next year) and Confirmation (10 years and above).
