**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION:** Registration is now open for children who do not currently attend St. Modwen's Catholic School and would like to do their catechism in Church in preparation for Reconciliation, First Holy Communion (children who will be 7 or over by May next year) and Confirmation (10 years and above). Catechism classes start on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November in the parish centre, 9:30am to 10:30am (First Holy Communion); 11:00am to 12 noon (Confirmation). Please do not send the forms back electronically. Return the completed paper forms to the parish office.
