**NEW ARCHBISHOP OF WESTMINSTER:** Bishop Richard Moth was installed as the 12th Archbishop of Westminster on February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2026, succeeding Cardinal Vincent Nichols. Appointed by Pope Leo XIV, the 67-year-old former Bishop of Arundel and Brighton takes leadership of the Catholic Church in England and Wales. Previously served as Bishop of Arundel and Brighton (since 2015) and Bishop of the Forces (2009–2015).

**ASSISTED DYING BILL:** Scrutiny of the Assisted Dying bill in the Lords has been thorough and given the number of amendments proposed demonstrates that the bill in its current form is simply not fit for purpose. However, the Assisted suicide pressure group, *Dignity in Dying*, along with other campaigners, are now lobbying MPs to try to use what is known as the Parliament Acts to bypass the House of Lords, their careful consideration and proposed amendments, and force the assisted suicide Bill into law in the next Parliamentary session. This is unprecedented and utterly inappropriate. It's vital that it is clear to MPs that their constituents do not support this profoundly inappropriate attempt to force assisted suicide into law. Your MP needs to hear your views on this issue.
