24 HOURS FOR THE LORD - "Walking in a new life" (Romans 6,4): The "24 Hours for the Lord" event, a Lenten initiative of prayer and reconciliation introduced by Pope Francis, this year marks its 11th edition. As previously, the event will be celebrated in dioceses around the world on the eve of the fourth Sunday of Lent, from Friday 8th to Saturday 9th March. Bearing in mind Pope Francis' frequent cry of recent times that there is 'not enough adoration' this event provides an ideal opportunity to respond to the words of the Holy Father as well as respond to the message of Into the Future-3 and the Listening Exercise as the Archdiocese prepares to walk in a new life, of the renewed formation and evangelisation for which our people are calling. The Archbishop Bernard Longley has encouraged each parish to take one hour over those two days for Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and an opportunity for the celebration of the Sacrament of Penance. Following this, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on Saturday 9 March at the end of the 9:30am Mass.

CANDIDATES FOR THE SACRAMENTS: Today is a Day of Prayer for the Candidates for the Sacraments. In our parish we have Hollie Dingley and Elliot Gilchrist who are Catechumens preparing for Christian Initiation, and Elaine Janet Ingram who is a baptised candidate to be received into full communion of the Catholic Church.
