Wright, Professor Tracey Rowland, Dr Holly Ordway and more in February 2025 at Word on Fire's Evangelisation & Culture Conference in London. The Bible is the heart of evangelisation. As St Jerome observed long ago, "*Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ.*" At this conference, we will uncover the spiritual and theological meaning of the Bible from a genuinely Catholic approach, reading it within the context of the great and beautiful chorus of voices from across the centuries of the Church's tradition.
